It is access to information and services for everyone, regardless of their disabilities or functional limitations! Reaching the widest audience possible. Universal / Inclusive design.

* In an accessible environment, a person no longer has a disability!

Why Accessibility?

More people with disabilities are using assistive technologies to access information and services online through websites and mobile technologies.


Websites must comply to international standards for Web accessibility;

Qatar Web Accessibility benchmark; 2013 to 2020

- For 9 years, between 2011 and 2020.


 Mada ICT accessibility services team provided; Consulting, Training and Awareness sessions to several key; Government, Public and Private sector Organizations.
- The benchmarking results indicate in **June 2013**, the overall average score for key websites in Qatar was 67%.
- In July 2020, the total average score in Qatar is 89%.
- As a result of Mada's best efforts; the score increased 22% between 2013 and 2020, which is a significant increase.
- July 2020; Qatar Government Websites average score; 90%

Qatar Web Accessibility benchmark; 2013 to 2020

June 2013

- **Zero** organizations achieved **100%** score
- 2 organizations achieved 95% score or higher
- 3 organizations achieved 90% score or higher

July 2020

- **5** organizations achieved **100%** score
- 41 organizations achieved 95% score or higher
- 90 organizations achieved 90% score or higher



World DARE Index Ranking

Digital Accessibility Rights Evaluation Index (DARE Index)

Benchmark progress in making ICTs accessible in compliance with the; UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities.

Developed by G3ict, in cooperation with Disabled People's International.

As a result of Mada's best efforts, a positive impact on the 2018 DARE index score;

- Ranked 5th in the Word; Qatar scored 75/100.
- Ranked 2nd in the Middle East and North Africa, behind Oman



Qatar Government Organizations

Mada proudly credits government organizations that championed web accessibility compliance and which by good example, paved the way for all organizations to comply.

Case Study of Qatar Government organization accredited website;

- Hukoomi, eGovernment was the first government organization to achieve web accessibility accreditation in 2013.
- The best web accessibility score achieved by Hukoomi was a score of 99% in June 2016 with renewal of Web Accreditation status.
- Mada has also had similar results and success with Ministry of Interior and The Shura Council between 2014 and 2019.



Mada Web Accessibility Accreditation Program



Web Accreditation is awarded based on the following criteria;

For Qatar Government organizations;

95% score or better in online web accessibility monitor tool **Pass** Mada website manual usability assessment review

Between 2011 and 2020; 19 organizations in Qatar achieved Web Accreditation Status; Access Certified



International and Regional Statistics on Persons with Disabilities

- According to UN Stats; it is estimated that 15 percent of the world's population has a severe disability, just over a billion people
- If age related disabilities are included, the percentage of the world's population with disabilities grows to 18-20 %
- 2018; According to Qatar Planning and statistics Authority, the number of Qataris with disabilities is 8,530, Non Qataris 7,615.
- 2018 Statistics indicate that the number of **people in Qatar over the age of 60 is 66,536**
 - UN Broadband Commission Report; More than 96 percent of households in Qatar are now connected to the internet
